

Step 1: Go through all the other registration bits, including registering yourself as a student at a Japan-based school. At that point, it will often show that the seats are full for all the Tokyo test centers. Do not panic. Follow these instructions.

Step 2: (bottom left)

Click "Let College Board find a test center for you"

Things You Need to Know about College Board Finding a Test Center for You

If you are unable to find a scheduled test center with seats available, the College Board will use your high school and/or your mailing address zip code to attempt to assign you to a test center. If we locate a seat for you, you will be assigned there.

Please note: The ideal test center choice that we collect is for research purposes only. It is not likely that you will be assigned to your ideal test center since it is either not currently administering the test or is already at capacity. Efforts will be made to assign a test center closest to your ideal test center, and this will most likely be one of the centers already presented as having seats available.

The College Board will use the **same list of test centers** that you have previously searched. If your searches found ANY test centers with open seats, you should choose one of those centers and complete your registration.

If your searches resulted in only FULL test centers, you may follow the steps below:

- Read the statement below and select "I understand"
- Click "Continue" and follow the rest of the screens to submit payment for this registration.
- After the College Board assigns you a test center, you will be able to access and print your test center Admission Ticket.

No, thanks. I'll try again to select an available test center, or change my test date.

I understand that the College Board will use the same list of test centers that I have had the opportunity to search. If I want to make a change after the College Board assigns me a test center, I may have to pay the standard fee to change my test center or test date.

Step 5: finish registration and pay.

This will not be finalized until you do this.

Step 6: Log back into My SAT after about 3 USA business days and see if you have an admission ticket. As this process requires being entered manually, it takes time to get the registration entered into the system. This information is often not noticed as emails are not always sent out to confirm the placement.

**IF you want the Japanese Subject test in November: I suggest signing up early for Hiroo Gakuen if you live near Hiroo. ASIJ has closed their doors to students outside of their school, so they are not an option. **
